THE CHARTER OF RIGHTS OF ALL CITIZENS OF PRAGUE

Being aware of the needs and wishes of the citizens of the capital city of Prague, the coalition of KDU-ČSL (Christian and Democratic Union – Czechoslovak People's Party), SZ (Green Party) and STAN (Mayors and Independent Candidates) presents this Charter of Rights and commits to its implementation.

- You have a right to quality administration of the city, proper management, clear and balanced budget and fair procurement.
- You have a right to a friendly City Hall and its officers. Opportunity to comment on plans of the City hall and municipal companies, reduction of bureaucracy and the possibility to deal with the authorities on-line.
- You have a right to a barrier-free, cheap and quick transport around the city. The priorities are urban rail, subway line D and public transport for 10 CZK per day.
- You have a right to have children and to live at ease. We will provide enough places in schools and kindergartens, playgrounds and affordable leisure activities.
- You have a right to sidewalks, sewers, and repaired streets. We will strengthen budgets and competences of city wards.
- You have a right to lively and safe streets. Streets full of small shops will be preferred over hypermarkets, pedestrians will be preferred over cars.
- You have a right to relax in nature. We will not allow new buildings to be built in green areas, we will protect parks and green courtyards, we will plant more trees in the streets.
- You have a right to decent housing. We will build new public housing and launch a program to prevent loss of housing.
- You have a right to assistance in old age. We prefer home care and care centres, we will provide homes for the elderly and ensure special care in the homes.
- You have a right to contemporary culture on a world-class level and also protection the character of historic downtown of Prague.
- You have a right to a safe city without gambling. Shops instead of casinos and programs for prevention of crime.
